

Other funding opportunities for South Pointe Residents and Fellows:

1. Chief Resident Leadership or resident professionalism workshop –

Eight (8) awards of up to \$1000 each are available from the Brentwood Foundation for residents to attend a leadership or professionalism workshop. Each request will require a course description including fees, a recommendation from the Program Director, and a statement letter from the resident. The request with recommendation will be forwarded to the GRAC for consideration. Based upon year-to-date financial records and priority, a recommendation for approval would be evaluated by GRAC. Pre-travel approval is required if the resident desires to submit reimbursement from their education allowance following completion of travel. *Failure to secure pre-travel approval will result in no reimbursement to the resident.*

Complete the CCF Resident/Fellow Application for Meeting Attendance form and consult with the Grants Coordinator in the GME Department.

2. Special Travel – International Education Program or Experience -

Four (4) awards of up to \$1500 each will be available during the academic year to support international educational or experience programs. Each request must be submitted on the “Resident/Fellow Special Travel Request” form and upon return from the trip the resident must agree to present a 45-60 minute lecture highlighting the impact on medical education. A summary of that presentation will be available on the Brentwood Foundation website for others to review. *Failure to secure pre-travel approval will result in no reimbursement to the resident.*

Complete the CCF Resident/Fellow Application for Meeting Attendance form and consult with the Grants Coordinator in the GME Department.

3. Resident Research and Presentations -

A total of twenty-two (22) awards of up to \$1200 each are available for residents or fellows to receive for research or external clinical/research presentations. Completion of the “Proposal for Research Projects Using Brentwood Foundation Funds” form is required with complete explanation of the research or formal presentation. If a resident or fellow has been invited to present, the invitation and accompanying documents must be attached to the request. If the resident or fellow is requesting research funding, a complete protocol is required to be attached to the funding request. *Failure to secure pre-travel approval will result in no reimbursement to the resident.*

If travel is requested, the resident/fellow must complete the CCF Resident/Fellow Application for Meeting Attendance form and consult with the Grants Coordinator in the GME Department.
